

FUNDRAISING CONTRACT

1. The student has agreed to enter into a fundraising campaign during the current school year. This campaign is to benefit Firestone Thespians and its related activities. The student further understands that this campaign is not a requirement for membership in Thespian Troupe 5570 or for participation in any of its activities.
2. The student understands that he or she assumes responsibility for both merchandise and cash related to this fundraiser. He or she further understands that all cash and unsold merchandise must be returned to the Theatre Director within three (3) school days of the campaign's conclusion.
3. The student understands that he she is obligated to pay for all merchandise not returned within three (3) days the campaign's conclusion.
4. The student understands that he she will be assigned a numbered box of product that contains individual pieces of packaged chocolate. The student further understands that the individual price for this product is to be \$1.00 and is to be collected at the time of sale. He she also understands that only cash can be accepted as payment.
5. The student understands that he or she will be given only one box of merchandise at a time. The student further understands that they may collect an additional box to sell once their first box is sold and all appropriate funds are collected for deposit by the Theatre Director
6. The student understands that all candy lost, stolen, or otherwise misplaced must be paid for by the student within three (3) school days of the campaign's conclusion.
7. The student understands that he or she does not need to pay for unsold product as long as it is returned in good condition within three (3) days of the conclusion of the campaign.
8. The student understands that all money from this campaign will be deposited into accounts managed by the FHS Choir, Dance, Theatre, and Art Association (FCDTA).
9. The student understands that all monies collected as part of this campaign are to be turned over to the Theatre Director for deposit under either of the following circumstances: (1) all merchandise has been sold, or (2) the conclusion of the campaign. The student further understands that accounts outstanding after three (3) days of the campaign's conclusion are subject to a hold slip and other disciplinary procedures.
10. The student understands that up to one-half of the profit from this campaign will be used for general Thespian troupe expenses. The student further understands that one-half of the profit from this campaign will be assigned to a personal account in their name. These funds may then be used to cover expenses related to FHS Thespian activities including but not limited to conference registrations, trip expenses, field trips, personal stage make-up kits, and Thespian dues.
11. The student understands that his or her account will be cleared to a zero balance at the end of the school year. Funds earned from student fundraisers are not transferable from one school year to the next.
12. The student understands that "banked" funds cannot be transferred from one student to another. The student further understands that only funds they have earned themselves may be assigned to their personal account.
